Prerequisite: Students must be 15 years of age before July 2 in order to enroll. Students must have a passing grade in at least 8 courses during the previous 2 semesters.

Notes: A separate check for \$20 made payable to the Secretary of State will be due on the first day of class for the student's state permit.

General Information

Attendance Policy

Because of the compact and accelerated nature of summer school classes, it is vital that students attend every day.

- Only one absence per session is allowed. Any student who is absent twice within a session, regardless of the reason, will forfeit the credit and fees and be dismissed from the class.
- Tardies (10 minutes or less) – 3 tardies will count as ½ day absence
- Late (more than 10 minutes) – will count as ½ day absence
- Should July 4th fall on a weekday, it is considered an attendance day

Breakfast/Lunch

Breakfast and lunch will be provided free to all summer school students until June 30th.

Course Availability

All courses require a sufficient number of student registrants. If there is not sufficient interest in a particular course or a teacher cannot be hired then the course will not be provided during summer school.

Course Enrollment

There will be a cap of 25 students per class (depending on the class) on a first-come-first-served basis. Once a course has reached maximum enrollment a waiting list will then be started. Payment secures your place in a course. Enrollment confirmation letters with bus information, room assignments, and teacher information will be mailed in early May once rosters are finalized.

Fee Waivers

Students eligible for free lunch during the 2020-2021 school year will be granted a fee waiver for summer school. Contact Mrs. Shore at ashore@ms.k12.il.us for the registration form.

Refunds

All fees will be refunded if a course is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or a teacher cannot be hired. One-half the tuition will be refunded if a student cancels before June 1st. There will be no full refunds.

Transportation

Transportation may be requested for students. Please be sure to mark the appropriate box when registering online. Bussing information will be provided prior to the start of summer school. It is critical that students who request bus service be at their bus stop on time for pick-up and ride on a daily basis.
