1. MSHS Senior
2. Major or minor in:
 Theatre (acting, directing, musical theatre, technical theatre, etc.)
 Or Performing Arts (theatre, vocal or instrumental music, dance), film
 Or Education (concentrating on theatre, music, speech, drama or music therapy,
 or other related field
3. MSHS Thespian
4. Participated in MSHS Drama program on or off stage for at least three productions
5. Must provide a copy of college acceptance letter (from a two or four year college, conservatory, or other post-secondary institution that relates to major or minor)

Address the following topics:

- Reason for choosing your field of study
- How your participation in the MSHS Drama program has affected your life
- Why you are applying for this scholarship and how you feel it will help accomplish your goals
- What role do you envision Fine Arts having in your adult life?
- At the end of your essay, please include the following statement:
 “I hereby certify that all of the information included is true and correct.”
- Include your signature and date.

Scholarship Selection Committee will consist of three members of the Mahomet-Seymour Drama Boosters, including the Drama sponsor. None of these committee members may be a parent or guardian of any of the applicants for this scholarship.
