CRITERIA:

1. MSHS Senior
2. GPA: 4.0 (B)
3. Be accepted at a college, university, or vocational/technical school
4. Submit completed application by deadline

The scholarship committee will consider the following when selecting recipients:

Academic achievement
Involvement in extracurricular activities
Quality of essay responses
Financial need
Scholarships already received

The scholarship recipients will be chosen before graduation, but the scholarship money will be awarded after the successful completion of the first semester of post secondary school. The scholarship money will be paid on February 1st of the student's freshman year of college.

***In order to receive the cash award, the student must send a copy of his/her first semester college grades to Mrs. Colbert at Mahomet-Seymour High School.**
